The Office of Public Accountability proudly acknowledges the academic achievement of Auditor III Vincent Duenas as he was awarded a Master's in Public Administration (MPA) from the University of Guam on May 30, 2010. The MPA degree is an interdisciplinary program aimed to provide students with a professional education in public administration and to prepare them for public service careers at the territorial, regional, federal, and international levels. The program also offers opportunities for government employees to enhance and improve skills, and to learn new concepts and theories of public administration and management.

A 1998 graduate of George Washington Senior High School, Vincent graduated with a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science from the University of Guam in December 2001. He was hired as a Management Analyst I in September 2003. He is currently an Auditor III.

Vincent's work includes performing audits, examinations, evaluations, analyses, and reviews, which are of moderate complexity, difficulty, and limited scope, and/or serving as a team leader for projects of appropriate complexity or difficulty. Vincent is a member of the Institute of Internal Auditors, the Association of Certified Fraud Examiners, and the Association of Government Accountants. He currently serves as the AGA Guam Chapter President-Elect. Vincent was also a recipient of the Pedro "Doc" Sanchez Scholarship Award.
