March 11, 2010. The Office of Public Accountability proudly announces the national designation of Auditor III Llewelyn R. Terlaje as a Certified Government Auditing Professional (CGAP). The CGAP is a specialty certification designed for and by public-sector internal auditing practitioners and tests the knowledge of the unique features of public-sector internal auditing — fund accounting, grants, legislative oversight, confidentiality rights, and more.

A 1999 graduate of John F. Kennedy High School, Llewelyn graduated magna cum laude with a Bachelor of Business Administration Accounting from the University of Guam in December 2003. During her last semester at UOG, she received an internship with the Office of Public Accountability and was later hired full-time as an Auditor I in January 2005. She currently is an Auditor III.

Llewelyn's work includes performing audits, examinations, evaluations, analyses, and reviews, which are of moderate complexity, difficulty, and limited scope, and/or serving as a team leader for projects of appropriate complexity or difficulty. Llewelyn is a member of the Institute of Internal Auditors and Association of Government Accountants. She currently serves as the AGA Guam Chapter Community Service Chairperson.
